



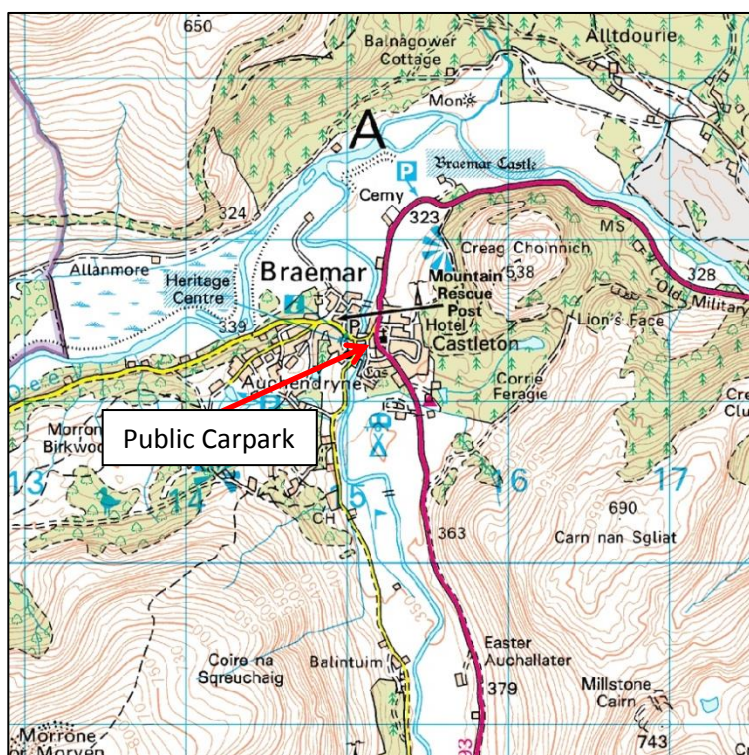
**IFM (Scottish Branch) TRAINING EVENT 2nd November 2017**

ATTENDEES WILL BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO CONSTRUCT SMALL TREE ENCLOSURES, PLANT TREES & INSTALL WILLOW BANK REVETMENT
